

## **Immunization / Medication Laws**

- All campers must have up-to-date immunizations records on file in the camp Health Office as required by the New York State Department of Health.
- If your child requires medication, or even and less “as needed” basis, please sign and submit the “prescriber authorization form” in this packet. Note that your child's pediatrician must also sign the bottom of this form and include copies of all prescriptions. Doctor orders are required for all over the counter as needed meds.
- Those campers who are CITs must carry self-medication, such as an inhaler, BUT MUST submit a medical authorization and prescription stating this. This form must be signed by a parent and the camper’s pediatrician (NO ORAL SELF-MEDICATION ALLOWED).
- If your child takes Advil, Motrin, and / or Tylenol for headaches, cramps, pain, ect., please provide us with a prescription from your child's pediatrician. WE ARE NOT PERMITTED, BY NYS LAW, TO ACCEPT A PARENT NOTE TO ADMINISTER MEDICINE- NO EXCEPTIONS!! You will be notified by a camp administrator if such an emergency should arise and will be asked to come to camp to administer these medications to your child yourself.
